

## How to Set up a Jumping Castle

1. First locate the smoothest most level place in the garden or the area where the jumping castle will be set up. An inflatable can be set up on bumpy ground but obviously the flatter the ground the better. If it is going on a rough, dry, abrasive piece of land or concrete a tarp must be placed under the unit.
2. Unroll and unfold the inflatable.
3. Position as required, avoiding objects close to the castle that may pose a damage it i.e. tree branches, stones. Spread out each side as much as they will. **Do not drag the inflatable over an abrasive surface as this will cause severe damage to the inflatable.**
4. Connect the blower to the inlet tube/s of the inflatable (arm/s at the back or at the sides) and secure in place with the Velcro® strap.
5. Close any deflation zipper that are generally located on the bottom surface of the inflatable.
6. Electrical cables should be installed avoiding any tripping over- out of Children's way. They should also be fully protected from damage of water.
7. Plug blower cable into a regular outlet. Switch on blower and allow inflatable to inflate. It takes approx 2 minutes to inflate and please ensure there are no children on the castle while it inflates. **The blower MUST remain running continuously while the jumping castle is in use.**
8. **Keep Children away from the blower and the electricity supply**
9. If used outdoors the unit must be anchored down using the anchor points located around the base. **Please ensure the stakes are well into the ground so as not to create a hazard to Children.**
