

SAFETY RULES

- All participants must remove shoes, eyeglasses and sharp objects before the entertainment.
- Inflatables must be used under adult supervision at all times. This ensures that the children follow the safety rules and avoid doing anything else that might be dangerous.
- Keep age and size of groups compatible.
- Avoid unnecessary horseplay or dangerous behavior. Please do not perform flips, jump off walls, throw people or jump into other people while inside the inflatable. Do not bounce near the entrance as people may be entering or exiting. Have fun, but don't do anything risky.
- No food and no spray are allowed in to the inflatable.
- During bad weather, including rain, lightening, thunder or heavy wind, please exit the inflatable and turn off the equipment.
- If the inflatable deflates, please evacuate participants immediately. Check the power cord for disconnection. Please contact us immediately.
- Individuals with health concerns should not use inflatables. People with head, neck, back or other muscular-skeletal injuries or disabilities, pregnant women, small infants and anyone who may be susceptible to injury from falls, bumps or bouncing are not permitted in the inflatable at any time.
- Inflatable can turn over in high winds. Upload participants immediately if wind exceeds 25 m.p.h
- Inflatable will be anchored to the ground at all times with spikes and should never be removed.
